b. *Georgia Municipal Guide Database* includes selected population, housing, education, and the racial composition of 512 municipalities from 1930 to 1990. The database, developed in 1983 is available in a Lotus/Symphony format.

c. *Georgia Housing Guide Database* includes selected housing information from the 1960, 1970, 1980 and 1990 Censuses of Housing. The database is available in a Lotus/Symphony format. The information was developed to assist decision makers to better understand housing trends. The database was specifically created to complement the information from the 1990 Census of Housing.

d. *Black Belt Database* includes population, educational and racial information for 16 Southern states on a county level basis from 1930 to 1990. The database, developed in 1989, is available in a Lotus/Symphony format.

e. *U.S. Forest Service Southern Region Database* includes population, land area, area of land in forest, distance from federal forest and forest industry related income derived from U.S. Department of Commerce Standard Industrial Codes (SIC) for over 1400 counties in the 14 state Southern Region. The data base is available in a Lotus/Symphony Format.

f. *Georgia County Guide Web Site*, www.Gafacts.net is a compilation of 57 selected variables for all 159 of the state's counties.

g. *GoGeorgia Education, Go Get It. Web Site*, <http://goga.jasonlynes.com> . The purpose of this project is to investigate Georgia's high school drop-out problem. Data for 181 school systems was collected to determine the number of graduates and drop outs on a district level. In addition a socio-demographic profile of the state was developed. The information was put together for Georgia teacher's, parents, students and decision makers.

h. *Ten Demographic Trends Website*, <http://outreach.uga.edu/changing-demographics/> which profiles Georgia on ten variables relevant to progress and growth. This website was developed in conjunction with the Office of the Vice President for Public Service and Outreach and has several phases that are set to be completed through the 2007-2008 academic year. i. Consulting with the Athens-Clarke County Human and Economic Development Department in establishing a *Bicycle Rickshaw Business* for a local citizen. This project has developed two viable job opportunities for local residents in a county with a poverty that is twice that of the state. Following in this same pattern, I have been consulting with various organizations to help a local citizen establish a doll handcrafting business.

j. *The Macon County Doll Project* was developed with the same goal as the Rickshaw project in mind. To assist in developing small enterprises in areas with similar socio-economic characteristics. Basically the project, which is a cottage industry type of enterprise, seeks to have low-income residents utilize their sewing skills to produce a series of unique children's dolls.
