Housing and Demographic Research Center, HDRC

Presently chairs the Board of Directors of the HDRC. This designation has helped to give the Department of Housing and Consumer Economics needed visibility. The Board of Directors has proven to be a politically powerful group. The Georgia Home-Builders Association is beginning to recognize the impact the HDRC can make and has included the Georgia Scientists as guests of the Legislative Reception.

HACE 2100. Family Economic Environment. 3 hours. A family as a producing and consuming unit, including decision-making process involved and the special role of housing. Emphasis on interrelationships among decisions and the links between economic and social issues.

HACE 3010. Directed Study in Housing and Consumer Economics. 1-20 hours. Prerequisite: 12 hours of senior division HCE course work. Designed for the senior major to permit independent study and research.

HACE 4300/6300 - Advanced Housing Theories. 3 hours. Sociological and economic theories of housing consumption and production in housing markets.

HACE 4310/6310. Housing Policy. 3 hours. Housing policies at the federal, state, and local levels as they relate to current housing markets. Barriers and incentives for housing development activities created by regulations, finance, and taxation. The role of public/private initiatives in the provision of housing.

HACE 4350/6350. Household Technology and Systems. 3 hours. Technological devices and their use within the household, including mechanical and electrical systems, home automation, universal design, regulation, and national appliance standards.

HACE 5710/7710. Study Tour In Housing and Consumer Economics. 3-12 hours. Maximum credit 12 hours. Prerequisite: Senior standing, one senior-level housing course or permission of department. A systematic study of topics relating to housing, or consumer economics, with site visits to relevant locations. Combines in-depth study with first-hand experience gained on site.

HACE 5900/7900. Professional Seminar and Internship Orientation. 1 hour. Orientation to an internship experience including resume preparation, interviewing skills, and job search techniques.

HACE 5910/7910. Housing and Consumer Economics Internship. Maximum 6 hours. Supervised work experience in housing, or consumer economics.

HACE 6810. Housing For the Elderly. 3 hours. Housing needs and conditions, housing alternatives, legislation and current programs related to housing elderly persons. Survey of current housing is compared to proposals for effectively meeting more of the housing needs of the elderly person.

HACE 8300. Housing Theories, Research and Policies. 3 hours. Theoretical and empirical housing models and concepts. Building on previous research, the student will develop and test his/her own conceptual model.

HACE 7000. Master's Research. 3-15 hours. Prerequisite: Permission of department. Research while enrolled for a master's degree under the direction of faculty members.

HACE 7010. Directed Study in Housing and Consumer Economics. 3-12 hours. Directed study on masters research in housing and consumer economics.

HACE 7300. Master's Thesis. 1-15 hours. (Max. 15 hours.)

HCE 567. Analysis of Family Resource Management. 5 quarter hours. Emphasis is on the development of problem-solving skills and management of resources available for family use through the use of case studies, simulations and laboratory experiences.

HCE 568/768. Management for Families with Special Needs. 5 quarter hours. Life-styles and instrumental functioning of families challenged by limited resources. Unique managerial needs of families with special needs will be explored.

HCE 571/771. Housing Alternatives. 5 quarter hours. Analysis of housing alternatives currently available to families. Public and private efforts to meet housing needs in the context of economic, social and demographic change.
