All four exams may be administered on the testing date and time, but participant may only take one of the exams during this session. AAFCS offers four competency-based certifications.

- CFCS- Certified in Family and Consumer Sciences
- CFCS-HDFS- Certified in Human Development and Family Studies
- CPFFE- Certified Personal and Family Finance Educator
- CNWE-Certified Nutrition and Wellness Educator

HOW DOES A PROFESSIONAL EARN AND MAINTAIN AN AAFCS CREDENTIAL?

- -Hold a baccalaureate degree in any major.
- -Pass the competency exam associated with the credential. Score at least 240 of 300.
- -Submit the certification application, fee, and undergraduate transcript. Meet professional development requirements during the three-year cycle (75 PDUs).
- -Ascribe to the Professional Code of Ethics.
