

#### GAINESVILLE FACTS


- Population ~ 48,000 people
- Employment, medical & retail hub for Northeast Georgia
  - ☐ Daytime Population grows to over 150,000
- Diversified employment base, including several international firms
  - **□** 60.3% = Services
  - □ 27.8% = Goods Producing/Manufacturing
  - **□** 11.8% = Government
  - □ 0.2% = Unclassified
- > Three higher education institutions located within the City
  - ☐ Brenau University
  - ☐ North Georgia University
  - ☐ Lanier Technical College
- Lake Lanier, which hosts nearly 12 million visitors annually






#### **KEY COMPONENTS**

- Prior to "Great Recession" Four separate departments
- Housing conditions became an important issue following the Recession
- 2012 began participation in GICH and visits to other communities





# Housing Sweep

- City Council Retreat & Bus Tour
- Goal = Improve housing conditions
- Deliberate, intentional approach with LOTS of communication
  - ➤ Pre-sweep meetings with City Admin, Mayor and Council, City Attorney & City Solicitor
  - > Inspections + Code Enforcement
  - Conducted Detailed Field Analysis / Walked door to door documenting violations – exterior and interior of units
  - Shared findings with Mayor and Council BEFORE notifying owners/tenants


# Housing Sweep


- Inspected 5 target areas, 2016-2022
  - > Target Areas with 40-200 properties in each
  - > Areas known for poor housing conditions
  - Some areas were identified as areas of blighted conditions during a 1960s study
  - High number of rental housing units, with multiple properties under single ownership
- Properties Inspected
  - > ~ 965+ Properties Inspected
  - > ~ 2,700+ *Violations*
  - > ~ 300 violation letters issued
  - > 1 Citation Issued

## What We Saw

- Tenant-Related Violations (~ 20%)
  - > Litter, trash & illegal dumping
  - > Storage of junk & salvage materials
  - > Inoperable vehicles
  - > Improper parking of vehicles
- Owner-Related Violations (~ 80%)
  - > Foundational / Structural Violations
  - > Egress Violations
  - > Plumbing / HVAC / Electrical Violations
  - Mold / Health Safety Violations



## Results

- Accountability & Compliance
  - > Property cleanup
  - > 135+ Repairs/Remodels
  - > 45+ Demolitions
  - > Demolition & Redevelopment
  - > 90%+ Compliance

**GAINESVILLE** 

#### Approach

- > Deliberate, Citywide
- ➤ Target Areas known for housing violations

#### Methodology

- ➤ All 4 Code Enforcement Officers & Building Official/Inspectors
- > Laminated card with house sketch and parts labeled
- ➤ Multiple days to complete inspections & visual assessments
- ➤ Worked ½ day on Sweep & ½ day on regular duties

#### Tools – IPMC & Boarded-up Permit

#### Incentives

- Demolition assistance (City General Funds & CDBG)
- Redevelopment Overlay District
  - Development fees waived for projects meeting certain criteria
  - Minimum acreage under single ownership with all structures demolished

#### Keys to Success = Communication is key!

- Close coordination & support from Mayor/Council, City Attorney, Municipal Court Judge, Solicitor, CMO & Staff
- > Relentless follow-through, will not happen overnight
- ➤ Halo Effect surrounding property owners reacted to improve properties
