Programming focus: Chronic Disease Prevention/Healthy Lifestyles,
Food Safety

In Appling County, the Family and Consumer Sciences program offers educational programs for youth and adults, focusing mainly on nutrition and food safety. Chronic disease prevention classes include topics such as diabetes education, heart health, and cancer. Food safety is taught to various audiences ranging from youth to the elderly. ServSafe Manager Training is offered twice per year. Responsibilities also include supervision of two EFNEP Program Assistants, who teach nutrition education to limited-income audiences, including the migrant population.
