PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: A Culinary Science and Nutrition minor provides a knowledge base for persons interested in foods and food ingredients as applied to food selection, preparation, home processing, storage and serving of safe and nutritious food to consumers across the lifespan. Food quality, as well as, the effect of culture, lifestyle, economics, and nutrition are explored.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must earn at least a “C” grade (2.0) or better in each minor course.
- 9 hours of upper division course work required.
- Courses taken to satisfy Core Areas I through V **cannot** be counted as coursework in the minor.
- Courses taken in Core Area VI or F may be counted as course work in the minor.
- Courses for a minor **may be** count in major required area.
- All prerequisites must be met for the courses.
