

Destination Dawgs is the University of Georgia's Inclusive Post-Secondary Education Program which will launch in January 2017! This non-degree Certificate program will support students with intellectual disabilities who are transitioning to adulthood an opportunity to prepare for a career and independent living over the course of 5 spring/fall semesters. Students will audit UGA courses, gain valuable job skills, and build a social network based on individualized plans supported by peer mentors. To be eligible for the January launch, completed applications are due on May 20th. Select students will be invited to participate in a Summer Leadership Program from July 15th –July17th 2016 as a pre-requisite to admittance. Students must be over 18 years old, have a documented disability, and have a desire to gain skills for self-determination, independent living, and career development at the University of Georgia. Students who are under partial or limited guardianship will be considered. Please see the application for specific details.
