PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: A minor in Human Development and Family Science will provide a knowledge base for persons interested in individuals and families throughout the life cycle.

REQUIREMENTS:

- MINIMUM OF 2.5 CUMULATIVE GPA REQUIRED TO DECLARE MINOR.
- Must earn at least a “C” grade (2.0) in each minor course.
- 9 hours of upper division course work required.
- Courses taken to satisfy Core Areas I through V cannot be counted as course work in the minor.
- Courses taken in Core Area VI or F may be counted as course work in the minor.
- Courses taken for a minor may count in major required area.
- All prerequisites must be met for the courses.
