

Joint Child Life Program: Application Requirements Checklist
Fall 2022 (updated 9/28/22)

- Completed Common Child Life Internship Application (<https://www.childlife.org/docs/default-source/certification/internships/common-child-life-internship-application.pdf>)
- ~~Verification forms for volunteer hours (on Verification of Related Experience Form in Common Application) Note: not required, but please include if you have them.~~
- 1 Academic Letter of Recommendation (from a UGA professor; cannot be from Child Life Director or Coordinator) – sealed in an envelope with recommender’s signature on flap. This can be a letter or the recommendation form from the common application.
- 2 Other Letters of Recommendation (e.g., volunteer supervisor, work supervisor, someone who has seen you work with children) – sealed in envelopes with recommender’s signature on flap. This can be a letter or the recommendation form from the common application.
- Academic transcript
 - Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
 - Must have completed 30 hours at the University of Georgia
 - If you have attended multiple institutions, include all transcripts
- ~~Letter on letterhead, stating that you have shadowed a CCLS in the workplace for a minimum of 8 hours. Must be signed by the CCLS. Note: Not required for Fall 2023 admission, but please include letter if you have shadowed.~~

Please place all application materials in a large envelope, seal it shut, write your name on the front, and hand-deliver your completed application to the HDFS Department Office at Dawson Hall, Room 123. Do not rely on campus mail to deliver the application on time!
