- 12.) Please outline your professional and scholastic goals, and how receiving a scholarship will assist you (500 words or less).
- 13.) Please list all college honors and co-curricular activities, including leadership positions held.
- 14.) Are you a member of a fraternity or sorority?
- 15.) Have you been involved in 4-H.
