RESEARCH INTERESTS

My research interests focus on nutrition during the critical periods of development, from pregnancy to childhood. We have conducted seminal work on infant vitamin D requirements and continue to explore adherence and the appropriateness of current vitamin D recommendations for bone development. More recent work in this area explores racial/ethnic disparities, and maternal and perinatal health outcomes associated with vitamin D status during pregnancy. We are also interested in the diets of young children and how these relate to healthy growth, working mostly with vulnerable populations including those participating in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC).
